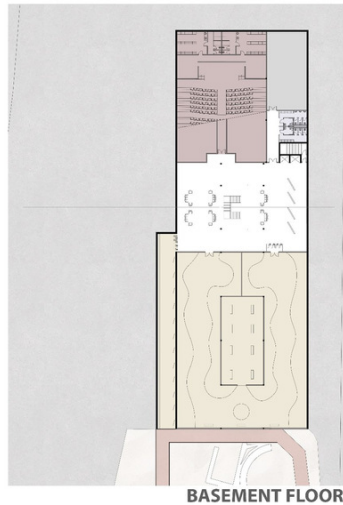
02 / Public plaza and landscape thresholds

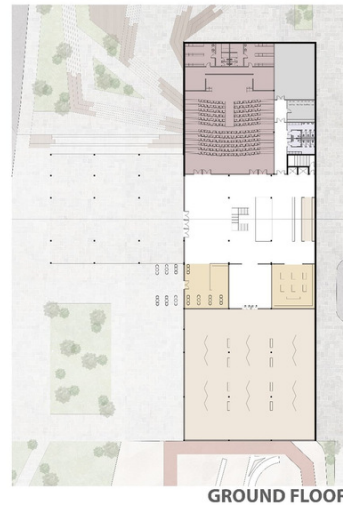

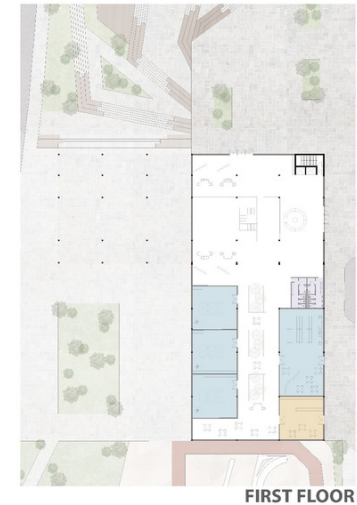

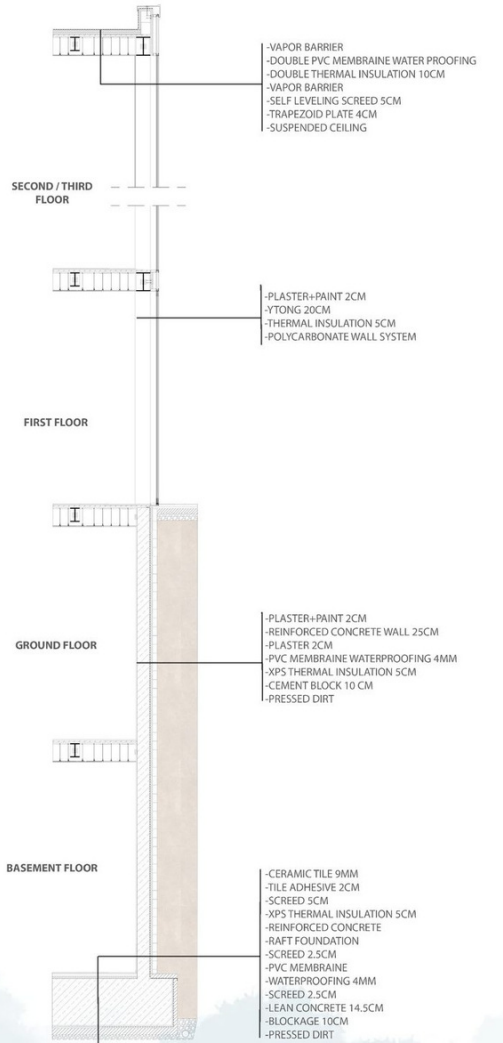

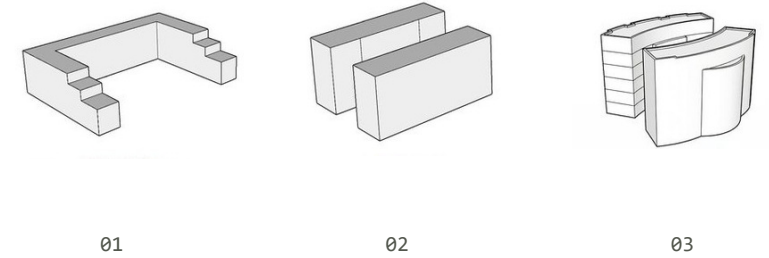

01 / Site plan and art axis



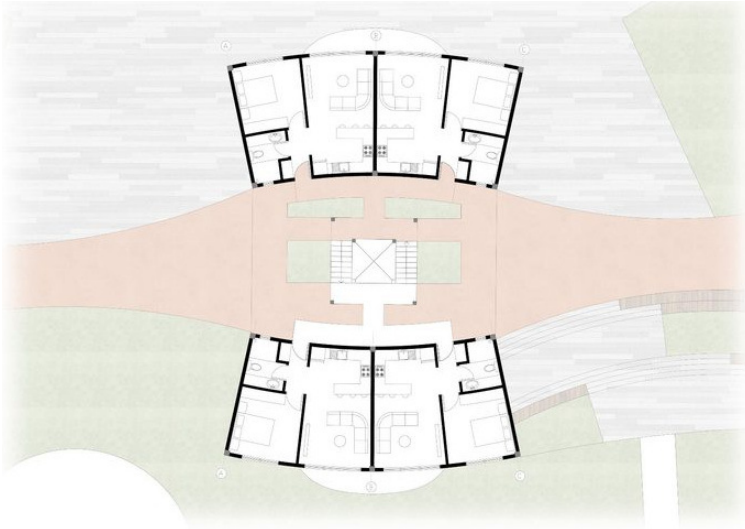
The perimeter opens around a central passage. Curved residential volumes define the edge of the sunken public ground at -3.00.

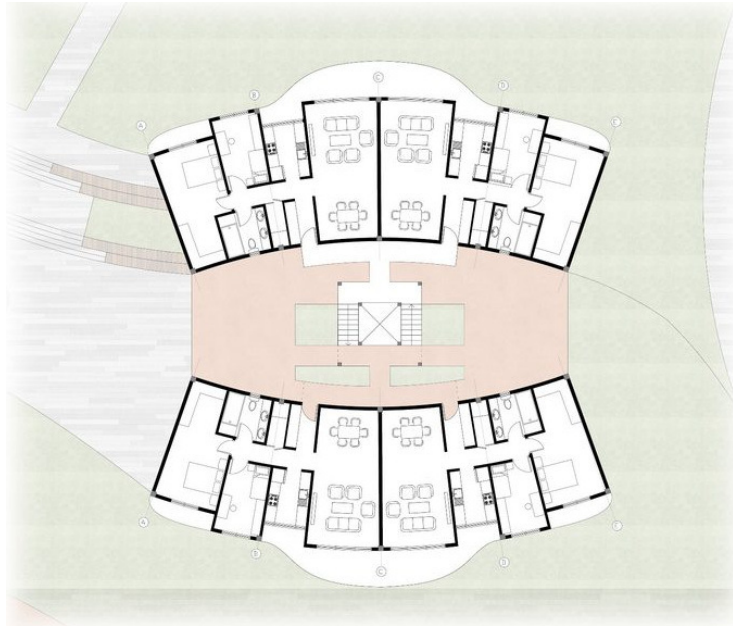

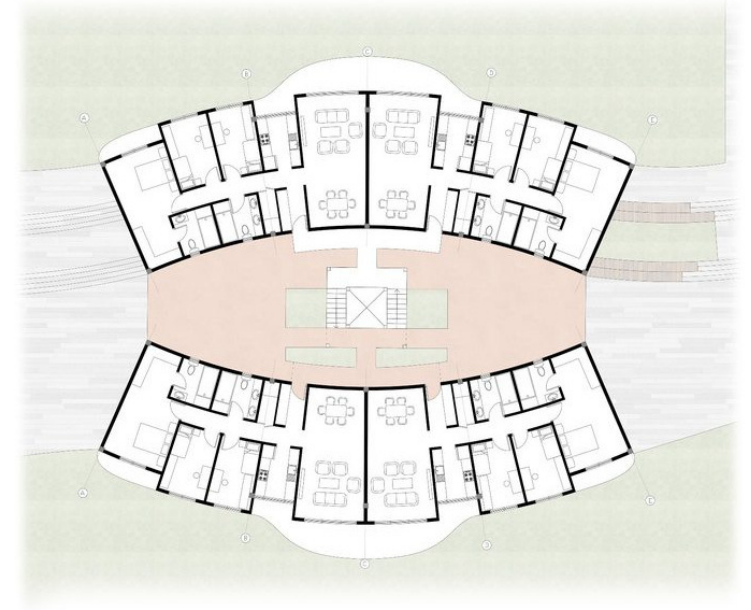
Typical floor plan

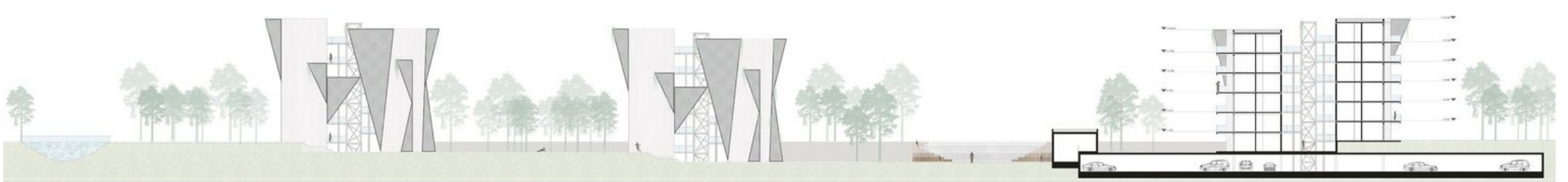

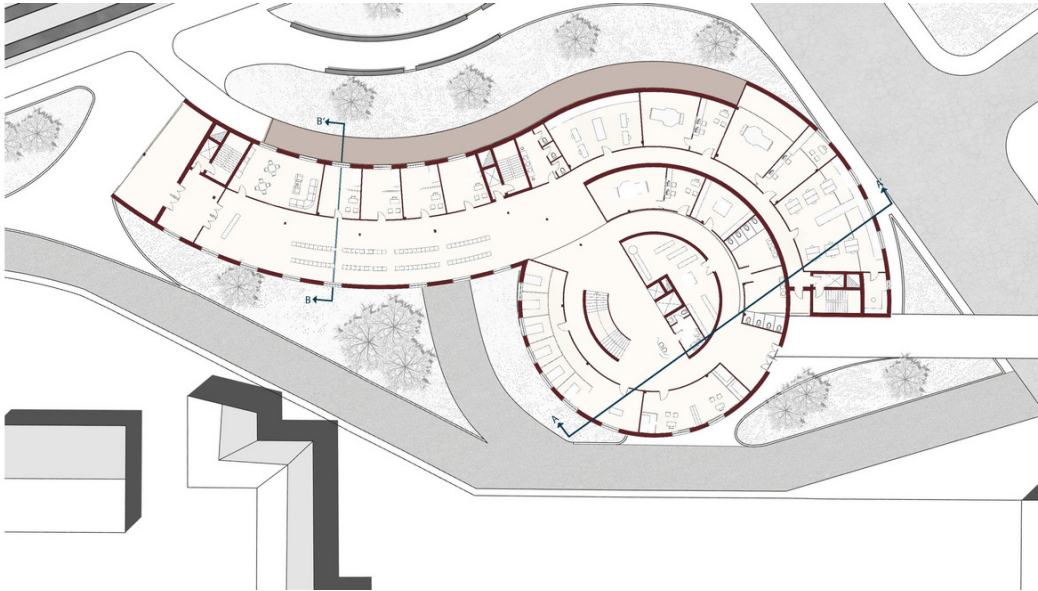

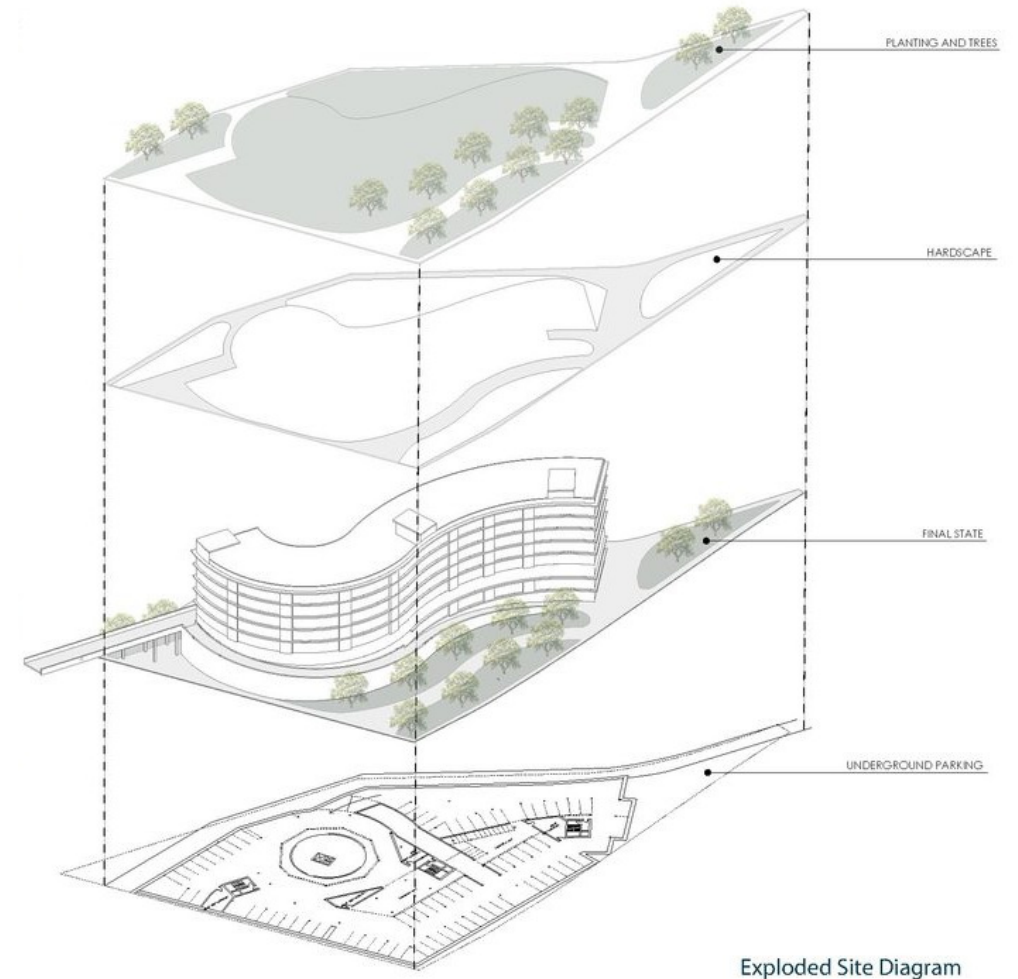


# The site, layer by layer

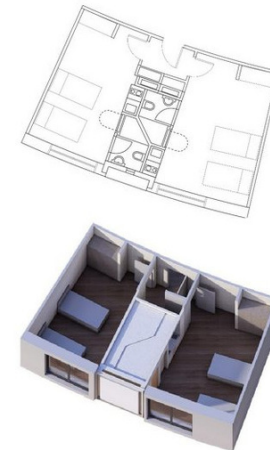

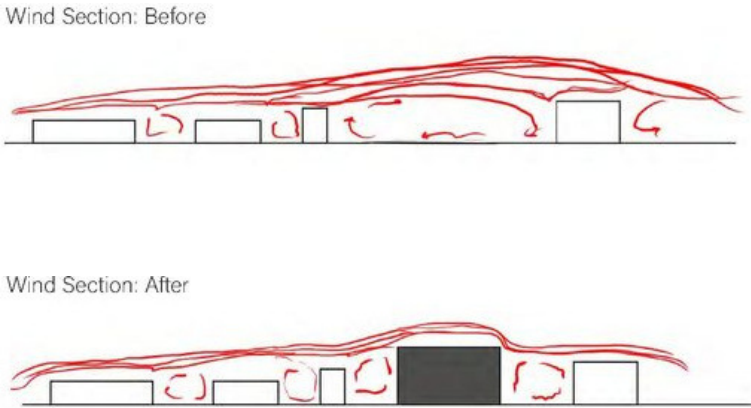

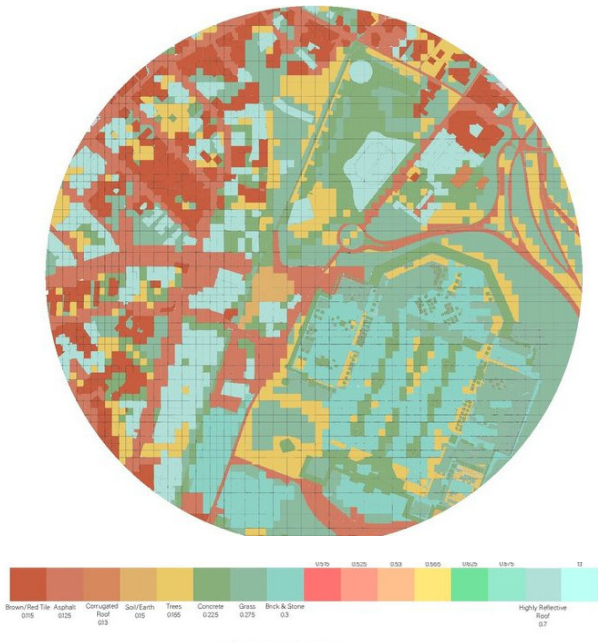

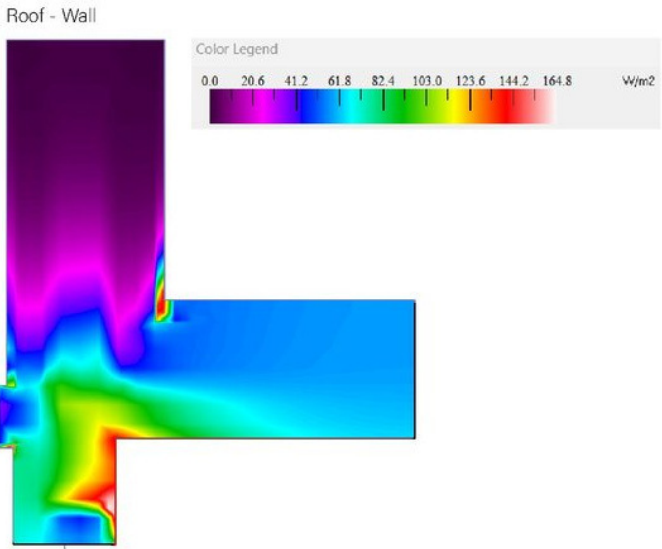

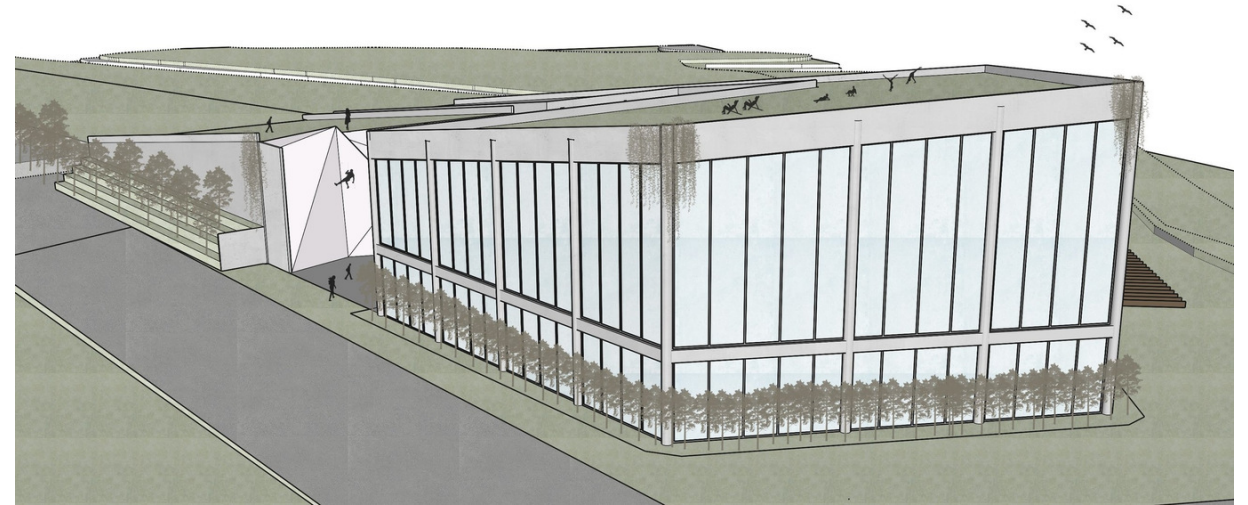
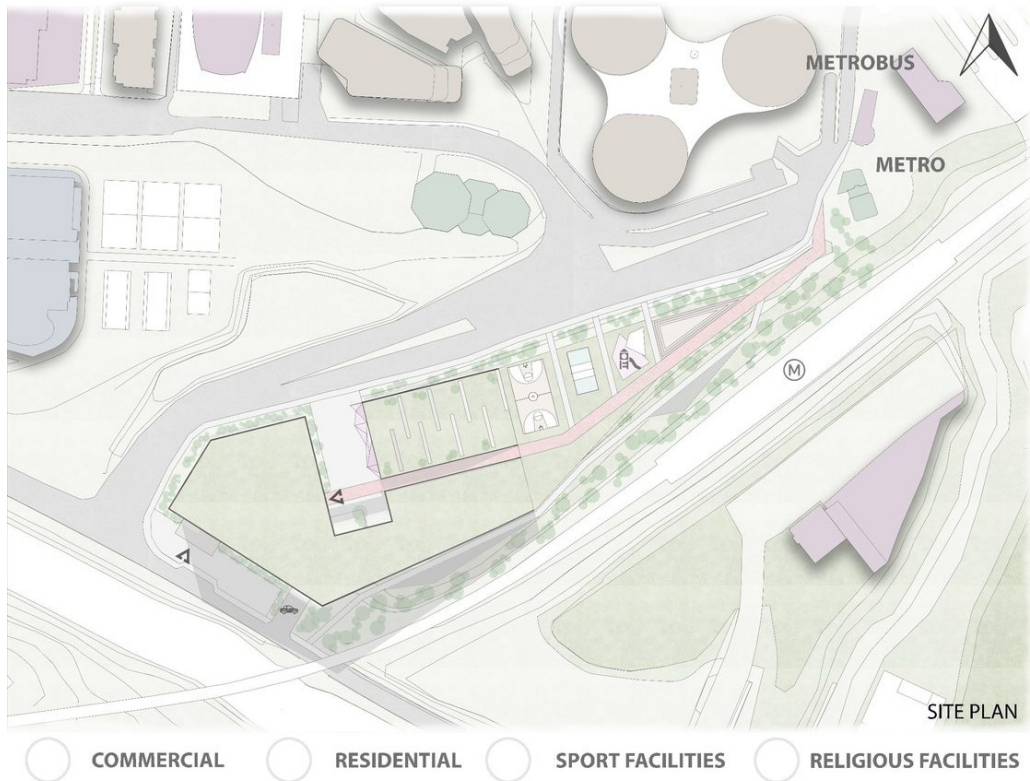
Sports and social spaces follow the terrain. A continuous route brings recreation and shared life together around a courtyard.

The courtyard acts as the meeting point of a continuous route. Changes in level connect the sports programme to the surrounding landscape.

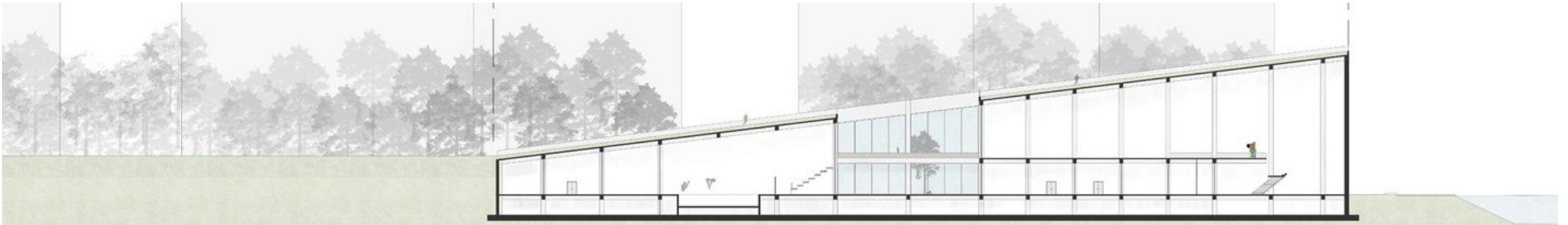

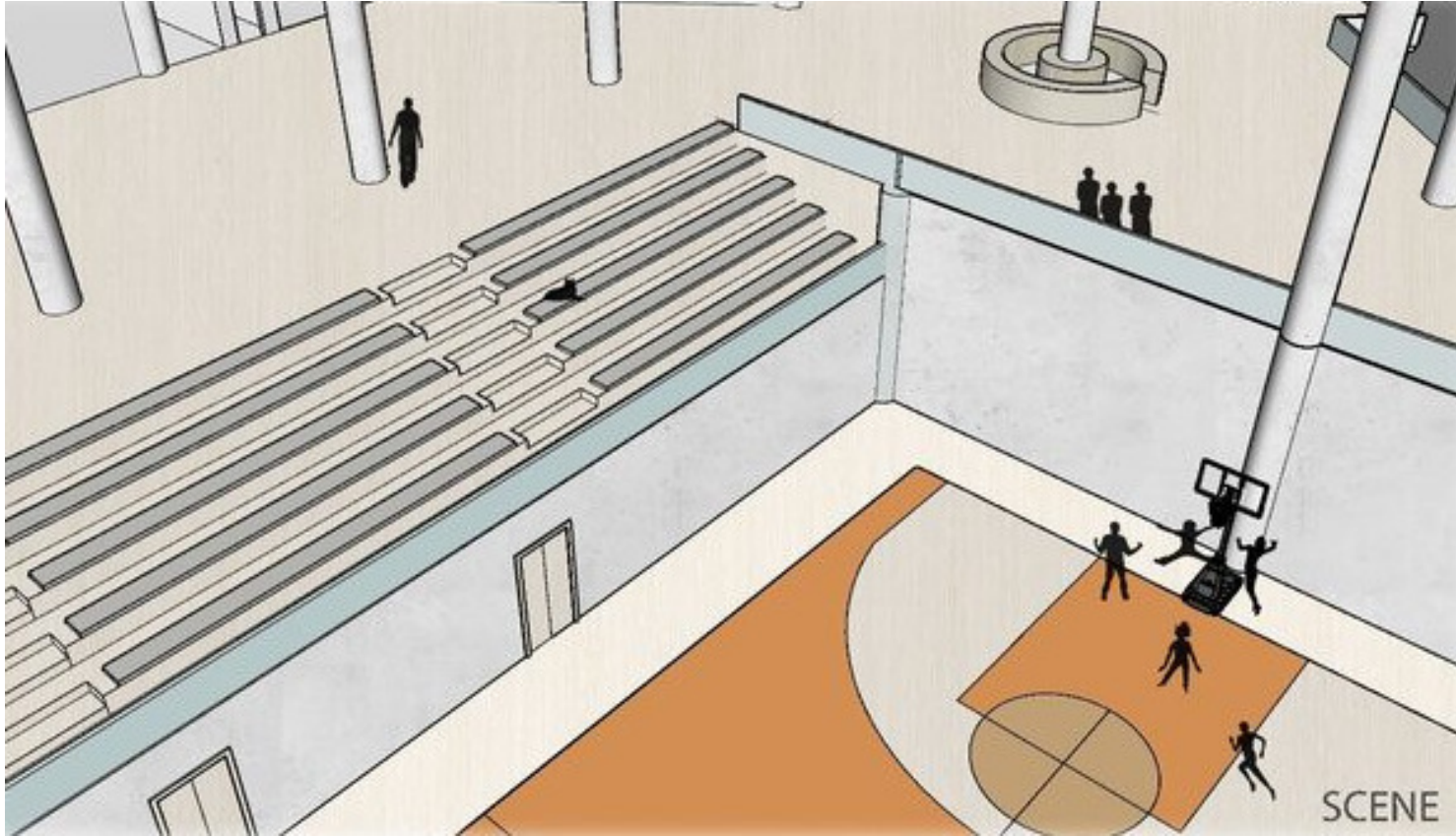

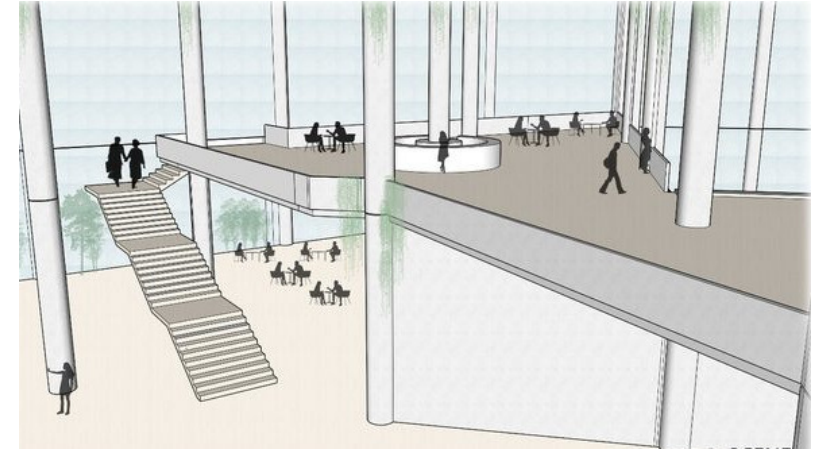
